The Board of Commissioners of Spalding County, Georgia, held a Special Called Meeting on Thursday, July 28, 2005 in their office in the Courthouse Annex, City of Griffin, Spalding County, Georgia, beginning at 4:45 o'clock p.m. with Chairman Edward Goss presiding and Commissioners Cecil Davis, Johnie McDaniel, Gwen Flowers-Taylor and Eddie Freeman present.

1. Consider adoption of the 2005 Spalding County Tax Levy.

County Manager Wilson noted the millage rate had gone down in all respects for the County for the third year in a row. The County's millage rate went from 13.46 mils to 13.41; Fire District from 3.08 mils to 3.05 mils; and School 18.90 to 18.85 mils. He had been informed the City of Griffin was reducing their millage rate, as well.

Commissioner McDaniel made a motion to adopt the 2005 Spalding County Tax Levy, seconded by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed by a unanimous 5-0 vote.
