What is "911"?

911 is the number AT&T made available to be used nationally as a standard emergency assistance number.

Is 911 available to me?

Whether it be a home, business or mobile phone, when a citizen is in the City of Griffin, Sunny Side, Orchard Hill and Spalding County they have access to 911.

Who does Griffin-Spalding County E911 dispatch?

The E911 Communications Center dispatches to the Griffin Police Department, Spalding County Sheriff Department, Griffin Fire Department, Spalding County Fire Department and the Spalding Regional Emergency Medical Services (EMS).

When should I call 911?

Call 911 when you have an emergency and need the Police, Fire or Emergency Medical Services.
