GRIFFIN-SPALDING COUNTY
2014 SPLOST SURVEY
WILL BE AVAILABLE THROUGH
NOON ON FRIDAY, JUNE 6, 2014

The time to let your voice be heard regarding the items you want to be placed on the 2014 SPLOST is coming to an end. The Griffin-Spalding County 2014 SPLOST survey will continue to be available for the public until Friday, June 6, 2014. The City of Griffin and Spalding County Government joined forces to create the 2014 SPLOST survey giving the citizens of the City of Griffin and Spalding County a voice in the projects to be included in the 2014 SPLOST to be voted on in November.

The 2014 SPLOST should raise an estimated \$48 million within Spalding County. The projects for consideration total more than \$106 million. We are asking the citizens of Spalding County and the City of Griffin to review the proposed projects. A 2014 Project Information Sheet has been included as part of the survey, you simply **click the link** at the top of the survey page and the Project Information Sheet will open so that you can review the projects and the projected cost for each item.

The 2014 SPLOST survey can be accessed through the City of Griffin website (www.cityofgriffin.com/splost.aspx) and through the Spalding County website (www.spaldingcounty.com). Once you submit your request, an email will be sent to you asking that to confirm your subscription, if you do not receive this email, your survey results was not received.

Hard copies of the 2014 SPLOST Survey are still available at the Senior Center, the Spalding County Library, the Courthouse Annex Office (Room 104) and the City Hall Customer Service Center beginning May 1, 2014. The survey can be completed and returned to any of these locations and the results will be tabulated and included as part the final SPLOST results.
