- b. Residential address (including the County)
- c. Phone number
- d. Age
- e. Date of birth
- f. Race/Sex
- g. Birthplace (City or County and State)
- h. Occupation
- i. Relationship of parties, if any
- j. Designated surname
- k. Last name at Birth
- l. Social Security Number
- m. Number of prior marriages
- n. If prior marriage(s), how was the marriage dissolved?
- o. Have you been divorced? If so, you will need to bring a copy of your most recent Divorce Decree with the judge's signature and filed stamp from the Court of Record.
- p. When and where did the marriage(s) occur?
- q. Father's name
- r. Father's birthplace (City or County and State)
- s. Mother's maiden name
- t. Mother's birthplace (City or County and State)
- u. Date & Place of your contemplated marriage (City or County and State)
- v. Social Security Numbers
- w. Have you together completed a premarital education course pursuant to OCGA 19-3-30.1?
- x. If you have completed a premarital educational course, do you have the proper form, completed & notarized, to submit? Only the state certification form will be accepted.
