Captain Morris has been nominated two times for the Officer of the Year award by the District Attorney's Office. He is Captain over the Criminal Investigation Division which includes Criminal Investigations, Youth Services, Victims Assistance Unit, Crime Scene Unit, School Resource Officers, Special Operations, CAGE (Criminal Apprehension Gang Enforcement) Unit, LAWS (Land Air Water Search) Unit, and the Sheriff's Tactical Air Response (STAR) helicopter.
