**Trail Resurfacing and Playground Replacement:** Scheduled upgrades include resurfacing of trails and the installation of new playground equipment. The work will involve replacing the park's trails with new rubber surfacing and replacing the existing playground equipment with new, state-of-the-art structures designed for enhanced safety and fun. These enhancements aim to elevate safety standards and enrich the recreational experience for our community. We look forward to the positive impact the improvements will bring to Airport Road Park.

**Closure Notice**: Please be advised that Airport Road Park may undergo temporary closures for remodeling beginning from the second week of August through September. Closures may include the entire park or just portions of the park to include playgrounds, parking, walking trail, and restrooms. Areas may be closed without notice due to constructions schedules. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding as we work to improve the park for the community's benefit.
